KARBON ZERO MOVES FORWARD WITH FEASIBILITY STUDY

Albuquerque, NM — Karbon Zero LLC recently signed a feasibility agreement with a group of landowners and an industrial facility in Southeastern New Mexico to study the economic, environmental and technical aspects of developing a wind project in the area. Ednen Hindi, President of Karbon Zero stated, "Feasibility is the first step of any project. The study will take at least a year, with two years providing even more certainty.
