Estancia, NM — The Torrance County Planning and Zoning Commission recently approved zoning variations for 5 meteorological test towers. These towers will continue the assessment of the G3 project, which is situated on over 80,000 acres of land with a promising wind resource. The towers will measure the velocity of wind at the site in order to further the successful development of the project.
